Vineyard description:

The Beckstoffer Vineyard is located in the cooler growing climate of Mendocino County, which allows for a slower maturation of the fruit, thus adding structure and complexity to the wine.

Winemaker notes:

This is a very crisp and clean Sauvignon Blanc. The nose shows pear and a hint of grass, the palate is nice and round with flavors of melon and passion fruit, the finish is refreshing with its balanced acidity. This is the perfect summer sipper! Pairs well with fresh seafood and shellfish.
