Vineyard description:

The 2006 Sonoma County Zinfandel comes from two vineyards. Martorana Vineyard is located on the north side of Lake Sonoma. This 10-acre vineyard is on a hillside in the middle of a 1400 acre ranch, giving it a distinctive terroir character. The vines are an old clone called Dupratt. Timber Crest Vineyards is the home of the winery, located on the famed eastside bench land of Dry Creek Valley. These 45 year old vines are the "old mother" clone planted on St. George rootstock.

Winemaker notes:

This is an elegant blend of two very unique Sonoma County vineyards. It is a big jammy Zinfandel with upfront aromas of black cherry and spice, blackberry palate, and finishes with dark chocolate and nice acidity. This multi-dimensional wine shows big fruit, but is balanced by earthy overtones and brambly spice. Great by itself, but pairs well with almost anything off the grill and shortbread with cream for dessert.
