## 2006 Pinot Noir, Windsor Oaks Vineyard Russian River Valley

### Vineyard description:

This 700 acre vineyard is on the eastern edge of Russian River Valley. Due to its expansive acreage and highly diverse topography, 250 acres were carefully selected for growing premium wine grapes. Our pinot noir comes from two different blocks on the property. Both of our clones (114 and 777) are blanketed by the early morning coastal fog and bask in the warm afternoon sun.

### Winemaker notes:

This Pinot is a blend of two clones, 114 and 777. Using traditional Burgundian methods, this wine was fermented using 25% whole cluster and a native Burgundian yeast. The nose has hints of vanilla, sage and spice (which come from the 114). The 777 adds a lively cherry palate with a noticeable minerality. The finish is smooth, acidic and the big bold pinot fruit lingers on. This could be paired with so many dishes from lamb to mushrooms (chantrel, porcinni, or morels) to a mild curry.
