Vineyard Description:

The fruit for this wine is grown at two different vineyards from two different appellations. Teldeschi Vineyard is located in the heart of the Dry Creek Valley of Sonoma County, and farmed by Ray Teldeschi. The Teldeschi family has been farming this land since 1889, and this vineyard has a long history of delivering intense fruit. Tollini Vineyard is located in the Redwood Valley of Mendocino County. Third generation farmer, Alvin Tollini, has cared for his family's land for the last 30 years, and continues to grow high quality fruit.

Winemaker Notes:

Rosé is not a second thought for us. We dedicate blocks of fruit for our rosé program and pick when the acid is high and the sugar is low. The delicate hue of this rosé is a direct result of harvesting the fruit at 21 brix and our gentle whole berry press. Delightful flavors of watermelon rind, orange peel, and wild strawberry fill the palate.
