



## 2007 Sangiovese Mountainview Ranch, Dry Creek Valley

**Varietal:** 100% Sangiovese  
**Appellation:** Dry Creek Valley  
**Harvest:** October 2007  
**Fermentation:** One ton open top fermenters  
**Barrel Aging:** 3 years in 100% French Oak, all 1 - 2 years old

**Vineyard Description:**

Mountainview Ranch is located at 900 ft. elevation on a terraced vineyard on Bradford Mountain. Because of the true steepness of this vineyard, it brings a huge amount of structure and acidity. Planted to clone 337, this block yielded just 2.1 tons per acre in 2007.

**Winemaker Notes:**

This Sangiovese is bright ruby in color, with aromas of creamy red fruit & sandalwood. Lean & bright palate of cranberry, finishes clean with amazing, lingering acidity. We barrel aged this for three years in order to let the acid integrate & balance out. An amazing food wine that will continue to get better over the next 10-15 years.
