## 2013 Grenache Dry Creek Valley

### Vineyard Description:

This Dry Creek Valley Grenache is made from two different vineyards, one from the east side of the valley and one from the west side. They are both farmed and owned by Ray Teledeschi. This wine is a true representation of the appellation; because it shows both sides of the valley and the varietal character is expressive. The Grenache vines are planted to the Alban Clone and on 101-14 rootstock.

### Winemaker Notes:

This Grenache is a beautiful expression of fruit and minerality. The layers of flavors are very apparent and the red fruit notes of cranberry, strawberry, and cherry burst from the glass. The complexity of the wine is shown on the palate with ripe tannins and a long finish that showcases the varietal and the appellation. This is a great food wine and pairs well with grilled meats and stews.

### Winemaker's Quote:

"I have wanted to make a red Grenache wine for some time now and this is the inaugural varietal that I hope to have a long and harmonious relationship with."
