Vineyard Description:

This 100 acre Timber Crest Vineyard is located off Dry Creek Road on the valley floor. The soil composition of this vineyard is Yolo Sandy Loam. We have $\frac{3}{4}$ of an acre planted next to our Sauvignon Blanc here at Timber Crest Vineyard that our partner Randy Peters planted for us in 2008.

Winemaker Notes:

Our goal with this Muscat Blanc was to make a style that would be similar to the beautiful Alsace wines that pair with spicy ethnic foods. It has a bit of residual sugar, but it is integrated almost undetectably with the acidity of the wine making it a definite food wine.

The aromatics of this wine are unmistakable and bring to mind sitting in a field of flowers in the spring! The floral notes are integrated with notes of citrus, melon, and honeysuckle. If you can take the time to get your nose out of the glass, you will find the palate equally as impressive. There is a beautiful balance of acidity with a touch of sweetness that fills the palate and finishes clean. The finish lingers and is the perfect match for the spice of Thai or Indian cuisine.
