## 2013 Petite Sirah Dry Creek Valley

### Vineyard Description:

This Petite Sirah is a blend of two vineyards in Dry Creek Valley, Teldeschi and Mounts, that complement each other perfectly. Teldeschi Vineyard is on the east bench of Dry Creek, and is planted with two different clones that we feel give the fruit a beautiful acidity, complexity, and structure. Mounts Vineyard brings a big, jammy fruit component to the wine, as well as big tannins.

### Winemaker Notes:

Dense and intense color; richly layered with complex flavors of blackberry and plum with expressive brambly spice. Ripe focused tannins. Bright acidity, and a lingering finish
