

2017 Grenache Rosé Pauline's Vineyard, Dry Creek Valley

Varietal: 100% Grenache
Appellation: Dry Creek Valley
Harvest: September 2017

Fermentation: 50% Stainless Steel / 50% Acacia Barrels

Alcohol: 12.1%

Vineyard Description:

This vineyard is located on Dry Creek Road directly across the street from the winery. It is farmed by Randy Peters, who was born on the property and is named after his late mother, Pauline. It is planted in the famous Cortina soil to a Grenache Noir clone with rootstock 101-14 and Grenache clone 362 with rootstock 1103.

Winemaker Notes:

After harvesting at 20 brix and a whole berry press, we maintained a cool fermentation in stainless steel for half of the lot, which allowed us to retain the fruit's natural character. The other half was barrel fermented using Acacia wood to build a rich mid-palate and complexity. The subtle hue and aromas of watermelon and strawberry introduce the senses to this wine. Melon, peach and strawberry juice explodes on the palate with hints of minerality, vibrant acidity, and a long mouth-watering finish.
