Vineyard Description:

This Sangiovese derives from a vineyard that is literally next door to our winery, Teldeschi Vineyard. Farmed and owned by one of our mentors and close friends, Ray Teldeschi, who brings old world tradition into the new world. The vineyard is on the East bench of the Dry Creek Valley on a hillside with varied elevation and 20+ year old vines.

Winemaker Notes:

This wine was aged in neutral French oak in order to showcase the beautiful nuances of this classic Tuscan varietal. We are excited to work with this varietal once again since our last vintage was 2007. This medium bodied wine is extremely food friendly with bright balanced acidity and overtones of dried red cherry and violet. This wine is approachable in its youth but can certainly cellared for several years.
