Vineyard Description:

This expressive blend is sourced from a collection of exceptional vineyards, each bringing unique character and depth to the wine. The Grenache, Zinfandel, Petite Sirah, Carignan and Barbera are grown in the organically and dry-farmed Tollini Vineyard in Redwood Valley, which is owned and farmed by third generation farmer Alvin Tollini. The Mourvèdre hails from Mizany Vineyard, our CCOF certified organic estate vineyard. The Sangiovese & Dolcetto come from our neighboring Dry Creek Valley estate, Teldeschi Vineyard, while the Primitivo is estate grown in our Timber Crest vineyard.

Winemaker Notes:

This Cuvée is a vibrant blend that captures the essence of Dry Creek Valley through a dynamic mix of varietals. Each varietal was fermented separately to preserve its individual character, then blended to achieve an optimal balance of fruit, acidity, tannic structure and complexity. The wine is exceedingly food friendly but also delightful on its own.
