2024 Chardonnay Peters Vineyard, Russian River Valley

Varietal:	100% Chardonnay

Vineyard Description:

Planted in West Sebastopol, this is a premier location for Chardonnay. The vineyard is next to Luther Burbank's Farm and the soil composition is rich Goldridge Sandy Loam. With the consistent coastal fog extending hang time well into October, this fruit is fully developed and loaded with complexity. The Chardonnay is comprised of Clones 4 and 76 and the vines are over 40 years old.

Winemaker Notes:

Incorporating concrete fermentation into the winemaking has taken this classic Kokomo Chardonnay to the next level, dialing up minerality while letting the Peters Vineyard terroir shine. Grown on Gold Ridge sandy loam in the emerging Sebastopol Hills, it's layered and complex with bright lemon curd energy—yet still effortlessly crowd-pleasing. Even self-proclaimed “I don't like Chardonnay” drinkers tend to fall hard for this one.
